To Whom It May Concern:

On January 28th, 2008, the Chastain Park Civic Association (CPCA) Board voted unanimously to support the master plan for Chastain Park based on the recommendation of our master plan sub-committee. In voting for the plan, it was understood that all agreed-to changes between the master plan consultants and CPCA sub-committee would be incorporated into the final version of the master plan.

In addition, on February 5th, 2008, the CPCA sent representatives to both Neighborhood Planning Unit (NPU A & B) meetings to support and speak in favor of the master plan for our park.

To paraphrase what is stated in the master plan, "The Chastain Park Civic Association represents the neighbors as the elected civic association for the host neighborhood for the park, with primary standing in matters affecting our community."

Moreover, the CPCA looks forward to reviewing conceptualized projects envisioned in the master plan as they develop, as well as working out the details to make sure our community's interests are properly addressed and protected.

As we have served Chastain Park for the last 30 years, we will continue to work in partnership with the City of Atlanta, Chastain Park Conservancy and other park partners to bring to fruition proposed projects that enhance our community.
